French 2 Tri A,B	FREN 102	5	EWU	Any student that has successfully passed French 1. Freshmen not eligible.
French 3 Tri A,B	FREN 103	5	EWU	Any student that has successfully passed French 2. Freshmen not eligible.
Spanish 3 Tri A,B	SPAN 102	5	EWU	Any student who has successfully passed Spanish 2, successfully passed Spanish for Heritage Speakers, and passed the STAMP test at a level 4, or teacher recommendation. Freshmen not eligible.
Spanish 4 Tri A,B	SPAN 103	5	EWU	Any student who has successfully passed Spanish 3, scored at least a 5 on the STAMP test AND passed Spanish for Heritage Speakers, or teacher recommendation. Freshmen not eligible.
History of Jazz Tri A	MUSC 356	3	EWU	Any student 10 th -12 th Grade. Past musical experience is helpful, but not required.
Leadership Tri A,B Tri C highly recommended	CDBS 200	3	EWU	This course is an introduction to basic leadership skills. It will cover models in a variety of areas such as communication, public speaking, decision making, problem-solving, time management, conflict resolution and ethics. The class is based on the curriculum and philosophy of Servant Leadership. The class is responsible for Freshman Camp, Winter Wishes Week, assemblies, Homecoming, and other activities that encourage positive school culture, involvement, and community. This class is eligible for CSBS 200 college credit through Eastern Washington University.
Psychology Tri A	PSY 101 Psychology	3 or 5	CWU	Any Junior or Senior who has passed World Geography and World History (Both A and B). Psychology and Psychology 101 are taught concurrently. Students who wish to earn college credit will be required to complete more work.
AP US History Tri A,B,C	College credit at most universities with a qualifying score on AP Exam. Check with the particular university for credit award policies.			Any 11 th grade student that earns an A both trimesters in World History.
Animal Science Tri A,B	AG 102 Animal Science	5	CBC	Any student who has completed AFNR or IPS. (10-12 th grades). Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher in BOTH trimesters to earn college credit.

Plant Science Tri A,B	HORT 202 Cultivated Plants	5	CBC	Any student who has completed AFNR or IPS. (10-12 th grades). Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher in BOTH trimesters to earn college credit.
Microsoft Office Specialist A Tri A	CS 107 Intermediate Word Processing	2	CBC	Any PHS student. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher to earn college credit. M
Microsoft Office Specialist B Tri B	CS 108 Intermediate Spreadsheets	2	CBC	Anyone who has taken MOS A and passed with a C or better. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher to earn college credit.
Sports & Entertainment Marketing	BUS 267 Marketing Special Projects	5	CBC	Any student who is a Junior or a Senior. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher to earn college credit.
Introduction to Marketing Tri A,B	BUS 265 Marketing Principles	5	CBC	Any student who is a Junior or a Senior. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher in BOTH trimesters to earn college credit.
Financial Algebra Tri A,B	BUS 120 Personal Finance	5	CBC	Junior or Senior students who have taken Geometry. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher in BOTH trimesters to earn college credit.
Child Development	ECED& 100 Childcare Basics	3	CBC	Any PHS student. Students must earn a grade of 85% or higher to earn college credit.
AP English Language and Composition Tri A,B,C	ENGL 101 ENGL 201 Additional college credit at most universities based of AP Exam score.	10	EWU	Any student who passed SBAC with a 3 or above. The criteria for the course is the same for Running Start English courses.
AP English Literature and Composition Tri A,B,C	ENGL 170 Intro to Literature Additional college credit at most universities depending on AP Exam score.	5	EWU	Any student who has passed the SBAC with a 3 or above. The criteria for the course is the same for Running Start English courses.
AP Biology Tri A,B,C	BIO 101 Intro to Biology College credit at most universities with a qualifying score on AP Exam. Check with the	5	CWU	This course is usually taken after a comprehensive initial study of biology. Biology—Advanced Studies courses cover biological systems in more detail. Topics that may be explored include cell organization, function, and reproduction; energy transformation; human anatomy and physiology; and the evolution and adaptation of organisms. This class is
